Property Update

We held a Special Church Meeting (SCM) last Sunday (16th April) to consider proposals about seeking our second manse (in Menston) and purchasing the buildings adjoining our chapel. We needed at least 50% of our church members to attend the SCM and were pleased that 62% came along. For a proposal to be agreed, we needed at least 67% of members present to vote in favour. The decisions to be taken were:

- 1. To permit the trustees to negotiate the sale of Manse 2 (19 Moorland Crescent, Menston) the minimum being £370k
- 2. To permit the trustees to negotiate the purchase of the buildings adjoining our chapel (24B-24C Oxford Road) the maximum being £435k
- 3. To permit the trustees to seek a loan from the YBA and/or BU (*to part-fund 24B-24C Oxford Road*) that is no more than £90k
- 4. To permit the trustees to make use of some of the church's cash reserves if member's gifts and/or loans, added to the YBA/BU loan, are insufficient to purchase 24B-24C Oxford Road the range being £5k to £25k
- To permit the trustees to negotiate either the early termination of the lease or the sub-letting of 'the Hub' offices, if the sale of Manse 2 and the purchase of 24B-24C Oxford Road goes ahead
- 6. To permit the trustees if the purchase of 24B-24C Oxford Road is <u>not</u> possible to retain Manse 2 and continue letting it out using the income for the church's charitable purposes

We're delighted to report that 96% of members present voted 'yes' to all of the above. Further updates will be brought to the church in due course. Please pray for the trustees - and especially for Tony Tofrik who is managing the property negotiations and for Liz Allen who is dealing with finance related matters. The YBA have confirmed that they are prepared to offer GBC a loan to part-fund the purchase of the adjoining buildings - up to a maximum of £90k.

Profile Update

Thanks to those of you who provided feedback on the church profile by the deadline of 12th April. The deacons took account of these comments and the final draft of the profile will be brought to the Church Members' Meeting on Tuesday 25th April when approval for it will be sought so that we can move to the next stage of the pastoral vacancy process. More about this will be shared at the Church Members' Meeting.

Church Members' Meeting

This will take place on **Tuesday 25th April** at 7:30pm when we will discuss a number of things, including agreeing to the church profile and the profile for a new minister.
