Pledge Day

Here at GBC, we are looking to sell our second manse with a view to purchasing the property adjoining our chapel. A loan from the Yorkshire Baptist Association (YBA) has been agreed upon to meet any shortfall as well as associated costs, but we would like to offer the opportunity for the GBC family to be fully involved in this exciting venture by pledging gifts or interest-free loans if possible.

On **Sunday 21st May** we are holding a Pledge Day so we know how much we may be able to raise through gifts and/or interest-free loans, and therefore, by how much we could reduce the total loan requirement from the YBA.

All pledges will be anonymous and not binding. After 21st May, when we know the sale and purchase costs, and the expected date of completion, there will be an opportunity to contribute to the building fund. Whether or not you are able to contribute financially, we want to thank you for your prayers, generosity, and commitment to GBC.

Emergency First Aid Course

We are looking into hosting an Emergency First Aid course, which would include the practical use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), such as the one we have in the yellow cabinet outside our building. The course would probably be over 2 or 3 evenings or Saturday mornings and would be open to everyone - no previous qualifications or experience necessary. However, we do need at least one person from each of the groups within GBC to attend (Youth, Mainly Music etc.). There would be no cost to yourselves.
