Building Fund Update

It is great to be able to report that the gifts and interest-free loans that church members and the wider church family have donated to the Building Fund are such that we will not (at this stage) need to take out a loan from the Yorkshire Baptist Association in order to buy and kit out the building next door to church. This means that, going forward, more of our income can continue to be used to extend the mission and ministry of the church, without having to use a significant part of it to pay off a loan over the next ten years. This is all down to our faithful God, and the amazing generosity of the good folks of GBC ... thank you!

At the time of writing, we have received $\pm 50,900$ in gifts and $\pm 15,000$ in interest-free loans. With the addition of Gift Aid (we will be able to claim $\pm 10,050$) **this brings our current Building Fund total to** $\pm 75,950$!! We're also aware that other gifts and loans are likely to be donated in the coming weeks.
